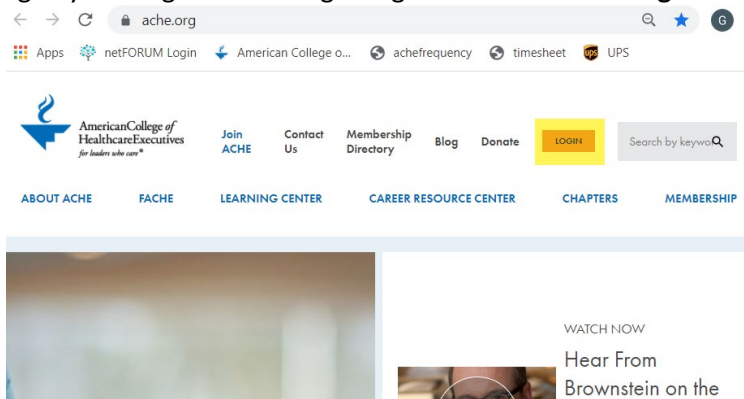


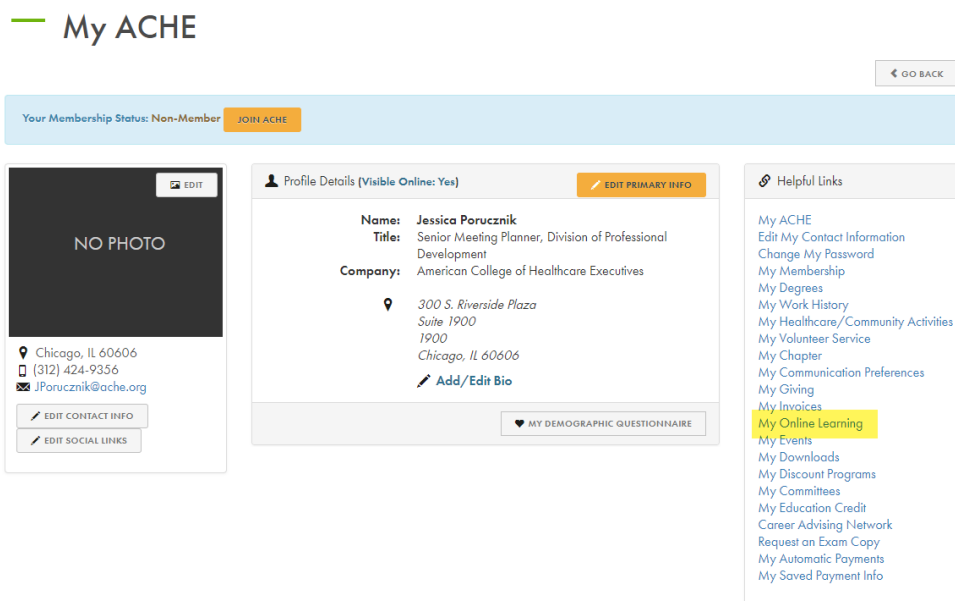
Instructions for Accessing ACHE Virtual Face-to-Face Programs

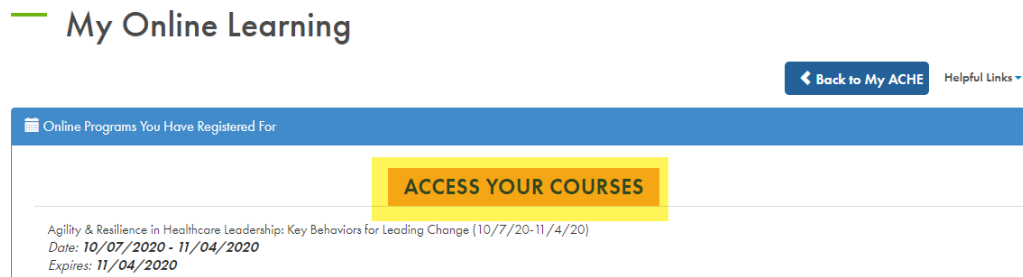
1. Login to your My ACHE page by clicking on the orange 'Login' button on ache.org



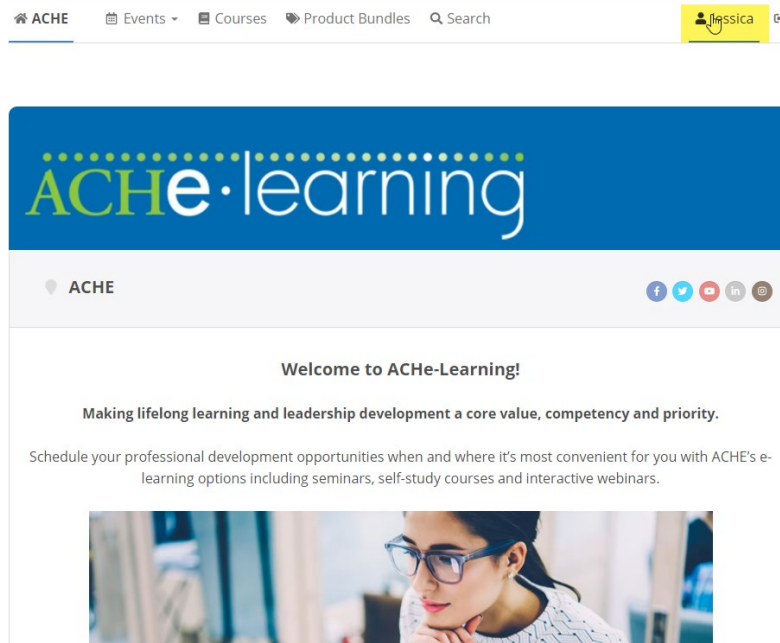
2. From your personalized My ACHE page, select 'My Online Learning' under the 'Helpful Links' menu on the right side of the screen



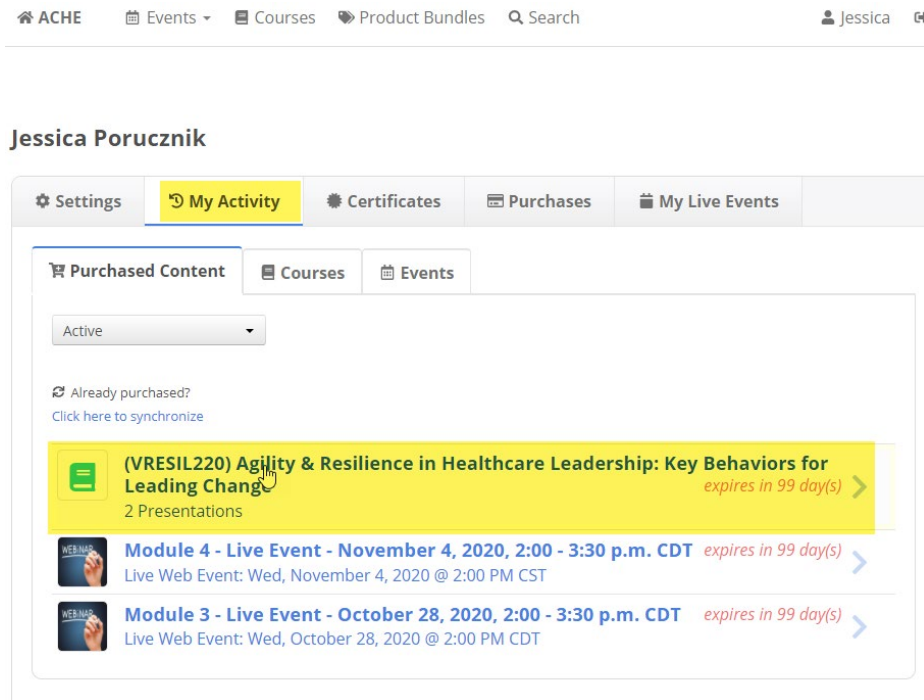
3. The Online Programs that you are registered for will appear. Click the yellow 'Access Your Courses' button to open the ACHE Learning Management System (LMS).



4. If it is your first time logging into the LMS, the system might take a few minutes to set up your account. Once in the LMS, select your name in the upper right corner of the screen.



5. The 'Purchased Content' tab within the 'My Activity' menu will display your course and each of the associated live events. Select the title of your program to access the main course page.



6. The main course page contains a session overview including the dates and times of the required live sessions, information about the Discussion Board and next steps. Scroll to the bottom of this overview page.

Discussion Board: (Required)
Each item in this course has a discussion board that will be used to respond to either post session questions, or reflection questions in your course assignments. The discussion board for each module is located at the bottom of the screen. Further instructions for each required discussion board will be available in each module.

Please proceed to **Module 1** and begin the pre-session assignment.
You will not be able to continue in the course until you complete the previous course item. Once you have fulfilled the requirements of the course item, you will see a completion prompt, and the course item will now have a green check mark to symbolize completion.

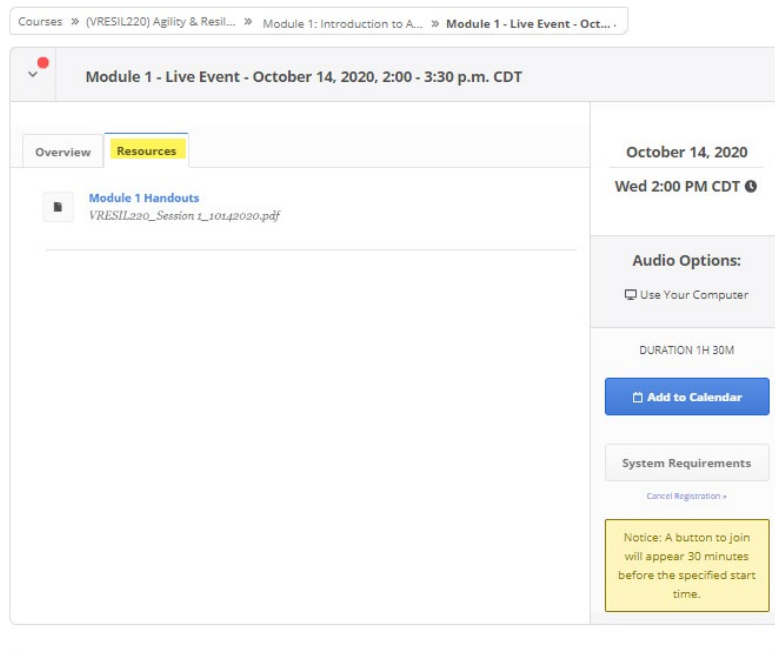
